



Guide to Getting Gift Cards

Step 5: Call the store

- ❖ Ask to speak with a manager about a potential charitable donation
 - ❖ There is a script on THINK: Resources Tab → GCI folder
- ❖ Explain what THON is and why we are asking for gift cards
- ❖ If they say they are interested in making a gift card donation, ask for who you should ask for when you get to the store location
- ❖ If they say no, thank them for their time and consideration

Since 1977, the Penn State IFC/Panhellenic Dance Marathon (THON) has raised more than \$156 million to help children in their fight against childhood cancer. THON, the largest student-run philanthropy in the world, is a yearlong fundraising effort by Penn State students, which culminates in a 46-hour, no sitting, no sleeping dance marathon each February. THON benefits Four Diamonds at the Penn State Children's Hospital in Hershey, Pennsylvania, which provides outstanding patient care while continuing to foster innovative childhood cancer research initiatives. Last year, THON raised over 10 million dollars, "For The Kids!"

As a THON volunteer, I assist in procuring in-kind donations that are necessary at all pre-THON events and throughout THON weekend for the Four Diamonds children and their families. Though THON is completely student-run, it would not be made possible without the help of several generous donors. Step 7: Go Pick up the Gift Card

- ❖ Go to the store to get the gift card
- ❖ Wear THON attire
- ❖ Wear a mask (covering mouth AND nose)
- ❖ Maintain social distancing
- ❖ Bring the printed GCI letterhead to give to the store's representative
- ❖ Thank the store representative!

What to do with a donated card

- ❖ Take the gift card to the THON Office! (227D HUB)
- ❖ If you have a receipt please bring it

100% Crediting

- ❖ All gift cards from the list of accepted stores can be **100% credited** to your Org, IDC, or Committee!
- ❖ Bring the gift card to the THON Office (227D HUB). You will be given a QR code for GCI crediting form that you will quickly fill out

Other Accepted Cards

- ❖ Donated cards aren't the only cards accepted!
- ❖ Cards from accepted stores that are purchased or given as gifts can also be turned in and 100% credited

Recap!

- 1) Search on THINK to see if your store has already been visited
- 2) Call the store
- 3) Prepare and print the letterhead
- 4) Go to the store for the gift card wearing a mask and keeping social distancing
- 5) THANK YOU
- 6) Register all stores on THINK
- 7) Turn card and receipt into the THON Office

 - Name and number (if known) of Org, Committee, IDC, or Commonwealth you would like to credit
