

## THON Weekend 2021: COVID-19 Guidelines

- ❖ **State College Borough Ordinance** (*effective through May 31, 2021*)
  - Familiarize yourself with the ordinance guidelines, especially, Sections 2, 5 and 6. **Do NOT** request exceptions, these will not be granted for THON Weekend.
  - Key Restrictions to Note:
    - Gatherings at all housing types not to exceed 10 individuals. This count is for the entire property, both indoor and outdoor spaces.
    - Gatherings at State College public parks not to exceed 25 individuals.
    - Any violations are subject to a fine of \$300+.
    - **Penn State will be notified of any State College Borough violations for further action to be taken by the University Office of Student Conduct.**
