Hospitality committee members serve over **9,600** meals to dancers, Four Diamonds Families, & other volunteers throughout THON Weekend.

There are **30,000** square feet of mats used to create flooring during THON Weekend.

More than **400** student organizations fundraise for THON throughout the year.

The Dancer Relations Committee, one of **16** committees, is responsible for the safety and well-being of each dancer during THON Weekend. These committee members are trained in proper stretching, health & nutrition practices for dancers.

More than **50,000** spectators enter the Bryce Jordan Center during THON Weekend. This number is recorded by a Digital Line Management System, which is developed by students on the Technology and Rules & Regulations Committees.
