## THON Cancels All Fundraising that Requires Out-of-Town Travel for the Remainder of the THON 2019 Year

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. (Nov. 9, 2018) -- THON has cancelled all fundraising practices that require out-of-town travel for the remainder of the THON 2019 year. This decision was made in consultation with The Pennsylvania State University following travel concerns raised over the past several years and after three car accidents this year while on fundraising trips.

"The safety of our volunteers remains THON's top priority. We will continue working closely with the University and THON Community to make decisions that are in the best interest of THON and our volunteers," said Kelly McCready, Executive Director for THON 2019.
